  - Brian, Road Commission – Discussed and clarified the Costco situation with the Road Commission.
  - Art, Saline Area Schools – Superintendent Search continues; negotiations with teachers and other staff underway.
  - Larry, Saline Chamber of Commerce – Discussion regarding a breakfast meeting with Ed Petykiewicz, Editor of The Ann Arbor News.
